SUBJECT: Guam Fire Department; Emergency Medical Service Policies and Protocols.

PURPOSE: To adopt Standard Operating Procedures for Guam Fire Department Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT).

THIS ORDER CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING-NUMBERED SECTIONS:

- I. Guam Emergency Medical Service Policies and Protocols (Approved by Medical Director EMS, November 1, 1998) In its entirety.
- II. RESPONSIBILITY
 - A. All Personnel assigned Emergency Medical Service duties are held responsible for acts of commission or omission when on duty.
 - B. Due regard when performing this order shall be given to all citizens.
- III. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION
 - A. Violation
 1. Whenever a GFD employee is found to be in violation of any provision of this Order, necessary disciplinary actions may be taken depending on the severity of the violation and disobedience to orders.

B. Immediate Supervisor of Violator

1. Supervisors shall be held responsible for their immediate subordinates' commission of acts contrary to or omission of acts consistent with this order. The Immediate Supervisor may be subjected to adverse action, depending on the severity of the violation.

This Order recinds all previous orders and directives relative to Emergency Medical Service Operations.
